GUIDELINES

AND INFORMATION

Hispanic Women in Leadership (HWIL) is a Houston based, 501 (c) 3 volunteer organization which encourages and promotes the development and advancement of all women in general and Hispanic women in particular. It is a service organization committed to promoting the advancement of Hispanics and women in the areas of education, professional interaction, leadership training, mentorship and the perpetuation of the Hispanic culture. In addition, the organization shall strive to provide a forum for addressing issues affecting the Hispanic community. **HWIL will award scholarships based on the criteria of an essay, academic standing, college/university/vocational/technical school enrollment, demonstration of leadership, letters of recommendation and verifiable residence.**

Award Amount: \$1000 per awardee.

Deadline: Postmarked by: Friday, February 5, 2016

Eligibility:

- Residence in Harris County
- Provide proof of enrollment in a college/university/vocational/ technical school within the state of Texas

Academic Standing:

- Applicants should be in good academic standing in their high school, or college/university/ vocational/technical school.

Additional Documentation/Checklist:

- Complete the application forms,
- Write an essay on the topic of "What makes a Latina a leader?"
- Provide two letters of recommendation,
- Provide current transcript in high school or college/university/ vocational/technical school within the state of Texas
- Provide Certification by Applicant, Authorization for Verification and Hold Harmless Agreement/Release
- Be sure that the materials are postmarked by Friday, February 5, 2016 or earlier. Late submissions will not be considered.

Judging and Evaluation:

A panel of judges will be evaluating all applications and essays. This panel may be comprised of HWIL members, leaders of the community, educators and/or others committed to the success of students.

- 60% Essay on the topic of "What makes a Latina a leader?"
- 10% Provide two letters of recommendation,
- 10% Provide current transcript in high school or college/university/ vocational/technical school within the state of Texas
- 20% Community service, acts of leadership
- Certification by Applicant, Authorization for Verification and Hold Harmless Agreement
- Be sure that the materials are postmarked by Friday, February 5, 2016 or earlier. Late submissions will not be considered.

Submission:

All applications must be complete and must be postmarked Friday, February 5, 2016. Send all documents under the same cover or envelope. They should be sent to HWL Scholarships, P O Box 540283, Houston, TX, 77254, via US Postal Service, US Mail.

Award Distribution: Will be made directly to the institution of higher learning after the receipt of proof of enrollment.
